I, JULIA G. LLANTO, Board Secretary IV of the Philippine Sports Commission (the "PSC"), a government regulatory national agency attached to the Office of the President, with principal office address at Rizal Memorial Sports Complex, Malate, Metro Manila, hereby depose and state that:

1. At the Special Virtual Board meeting of the Board of Commissioners held on April 29, 2020, at the principal office of the PSC, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLUTION NO. 733-2020

"RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to approve the cancellation of the Batang Pinoy, Philippine National Games (PNG), Laro't Saya sa Parke (LSP), and other sporting events and activities for Calendar Year (CY) 2020, as well as the 10th ASEAN Para Games, in consonance with the Resolution of Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF) prescribing the guidelines on Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) and General Community Quarantine (GCQ) and the directive of the President, in support to the government in the management of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)."

2. All resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby revised, repealed, amended, and/or modified accordingly.
3. That the above resolution is in full force and effect and has not been altered, amended or revoked to date.
